Jimmers stated he is expecting a release from the budget office of the allocation plan today, so that everyone can start looking at the details. It will simultaneously be sent to Barney for preparation of the schedule of funds. This is no guarantee. but it was part of yesterday's discussion with the executive team and assistant secretaries. He will also be taking time to add information and updates to the table in the appendix that gives the crosswalk of OCA covered services project codes. Greg says the goal is to have the initial draft on the 12th of July and distribute on the 16th of July. All feedback needs to be submitted back by the 21st of July for Jimmers and his team to review. This will then be published and made available on August 6th. Jimmers added they are expecting a lot of OCAs as they are required to keep the supplemental block grant for both SAPT and community mental health reporting separate from the normal block grant. In this case you will see mirrored OCAs. Larry asked who will this be distributed to? Jimmers answered this will go out through the regional contract managers and regional directors. Mike said he would assume that with the supplemental block grant funds we don't want to spend those before regular block grant but do concurrent to make sure we are drawing from both consistently throughout the year. Jimmers says this question will have to be taken to the block grant managers for an accurate response.

#### 2. FASAMS "Unexpected Error"

FEI will provide an update on their monitoring of this issue.

Jesse said they've been monitoring and haven't come across any errors as of the 18<sup>th</sup>. Diego stated the errors have been within specific files not overall. Jesse asked him to send this example over a they arise so it can be updated. Jennifer said she received a global error since this update and will send her snapshot as well.

#### 3. Administrative Discharge Question

Some of Netsmart's providers have asked questions about Administrative Discharges. Do they still exist in FASAMS and if so, what the criteria is, how it affects Treatment Episode/Services data submitted, and how they are to be handled?

Administrative discharge is still identified in Chapter 5 for DischargeReasonCode

Rich stated there is an administrative discharge, and the big issue is how to answer the questions on POMS. He will workout what used to be done in SAMAS. At some point the rules will be relaxed to allow for everyone to not answer POMS in case of a discharge reason code or at least selectively not answer POMS in the case of an administrative discharge. Rich asked if seeing administrative discharges is common. Larry said it can be. He then said having the ability to leave fields blank or NA is needed. Rich agreed.

#### 4. Option to include PAC in POM

Some of our stakeholders have asked us to consider options to include PAC in the POM without having to wait for version 15. This would make it easier for them to submit cooccurring admissions. We understand the need to not make significant changes to the system (i.e. data structure changes) without providing 6 months' notice to the field. FEI has presented an option that might not require providers to make any changes to their submissions if choose not to; but, allow some providers a new option if they so choose.

The details of this proposal were discussed in the previous meeting and stakeholders were asked to consider how this would impact their organizations and providers. This week we'll collect feedback.

Nathan opened the floor for some feedback. Beau stated it would work for them either way, to use or not to use. He believes this will be more of a concern for the MEs as they've already done their coding and would be the ones to have to change everything to use it. Rich said the key is there's no obligation. Beau said it is because as the provider once he puts it in the MEs must be able to accept it. Nathan asked if the MEs think they are ready for this change. Larry answered no. He said the anticipated November date is workable, but anything sooner is not.



Mike, Diego, Debbie, Johnny, and Jennifer agreed. Beau suggested circling back in August to see if November works as things change.
5. Required fields for FARS/CFARS Sharyn explained these fields within Chapter 5 need to be required.
Sharyn explained her concern is if we are going to stay with FARS/CFARS usage they need to become a required field otherwise they will not be filled in like they are running into now. Greg agreed but thinks the problem is policy issues that would need to be addressed first. Christi asked is it in Chapter 5 what she's referring to. Sharyn answered yes and the chapter was pulled up for reference.
